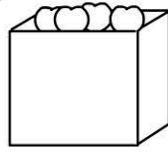

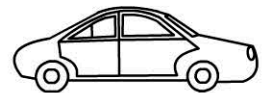


Last year the apple orchard produced 165 crates of green apples. This year it produced 50 more.
