You can't hum while holding your nose closed. Surgery that is performed to change the shape of the nose is called rhinoplasty. Women have a better sense of smell than men.

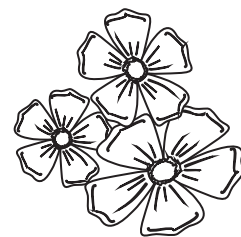
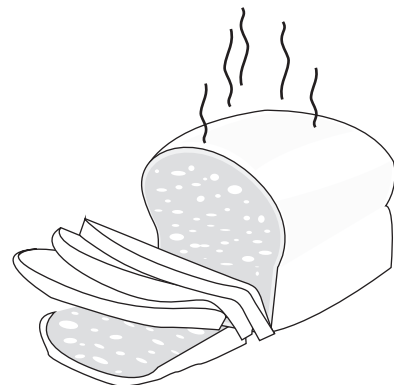

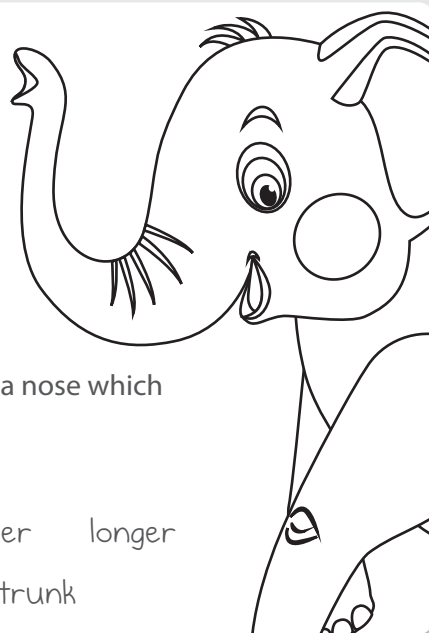
