More information:

Megalodon was an enormous shark that lived long after the dinosaurs disappeared. It grew up to 18m (59') in length. This would have made it even bigger than a whale shark! Scientists believe it appeared like an enormous Great White shark, but was more heavily built. It is believed that its great size was possibly due to it having a diet that included large cetaceans (whale type animals).

The scientific name of the creature is debated based on differing views on the scientific family it belongs to, making it either Carcharodon megalodon or Carcharocles megalodon. It is usually shortened to C. Megalodon as a result. Megalodon means "big tooth" because they can be over 18cm (7.1") long.
