

# Sensing Verbs

**Sensing verbs** are verbs related to the five senses (see, touch, smell, taste, hear).

Can you **see** the lions?

I **felt** the heat of the flames.

I can **smell** smoke.

Can you **taste** the spices?

I **heard** the dogs barking.

Sensing verbs can express a similarity between two or more objects.

Your father **looks like** his cousin.

That perfume **smells like** roses.



Sensing verbs can be used with adjectives.

The flowers **smell beautiful**.

verb - smell

adjective - beautiful

The stew **tastes wonderful**.

verb - smell

adjective - wonderful

The scarf **feels soft**.

verb - feels

adjective - soft

That song **sounds terrible**.

verb - sounds

adjective - terrible
