## Sensing Verbs

Sensing verbs are verbs related to the five senses (see, touch, smell, taste, hear).

Can you see the lions?

I felt the heat of the flames.

I can smell smoke.

Can you taste the spices?

I heard the dogs barking.

Sensing verbs can express a similarity between two or more objects.

Your father looks like his cousin.

That perfume smells like roses.



Sensing verbs can be used with adjectives. The flowers smell beautiful. verb - smell adjective - beautiful

The stew tastes wonderful. verb - smell adjective - wonderful

The scarf feels soft. verb - feels adjective - soft

That song sounds terrible. verb - sounds adjective - terrible
