# Adjectives of Degree

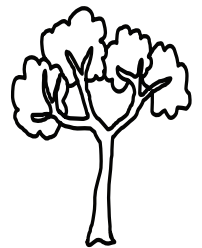
In English, we have many adjectives that describe the size of something. These words can be ordered to show a degree of size, that is how big or how small something is.
