

Brachiosaurus

Means "arm lizard" Scientific name: Brachiosaurus altithorax

Period:

Late Jurassic (~154 – 153 Ma -{Mega annum, or million years ago}) **Diet:**

Herbivore (plant eater) **Current day location found:** United States

More information:

- Was a sauropod ('lizard-footed')
- Characterised by long necks and tails, with proportionately small heads
- Renowned for their enormous size
- One of the largest known land animals
- Appeared first in the Triassic period
- Had relatively long forelimbs (the reason for its

name)

- Somewhat more upright in stance than other sauropods
- Estimated length up to 26 m (85 ft)
- Estimated weight 28 to 56 tonnes (the weight of 5 to 10 elephants)
