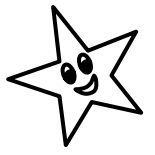
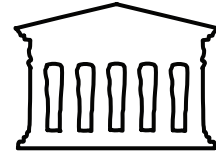




# Prefix Origins "mono-"

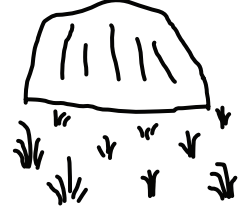


Adding the prefix "mono-" to a word applies the meaning "single" or "alone". This prefix has its origins in Greek.
