

More information:

- Multiple complete skeletons found
- Would have been a fast runner
- Based on its teeth and jaws, likely preyed on small agile prey such as lizard-like creatures
- One of the earliest dinosaurs to evolve

Coelophysis

Means "hollow form" Scientific name: Coelophysis bauri

Period:

Late Triassic (~ 203 – 196 Ma -{Mega annum, or million years ago}) **Diet:**

Carnivore (meat eater) **Current day location found:** South West United States

- Has been known to science for over 100 years
- It is the state fossil of New Mexico
- Estimated length about 3 m (10 ft)
- Estimated weight about 15 kg (33 lbs)
