The optometrist did lots of tests to check the health of my eye. He looked right inside my eye with a microscope to see that everything was functioning properly.


Then I had to read some letters on a chart. Some of the smaller letters looked a bit fuzzy.

Next, I had to look at some charts through this machine. The optometrist checked my focus. The optometrist swapped lenses in some trial glasses until he found ones to correct my sight.


Next it was time to choose frames for my new glasses. I had to try on lots of pairs. After I found a nice pair the technician sent the frames away to have my new lenses put in.


Now, I have my new glasses. I think they look nice and best of all — now I can see clearly!


