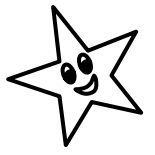




# Doubling final consonants



If the final consonant is preceded by a short vowel sound you must double the final consonant before adding "ing" and "ed".

example:



slip

+ ing =

slipping

slipped

Double the final consonant if the vowel sound is short:

hop	<i>hopped</i>	
rub		
step		<i>stepping</i>
stop		
clap
