Palindromes

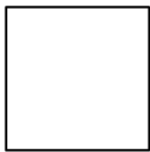
Palindromes are words that spell the same backwards and forwards. Examples are: dad, nun, radar, level and kayak.

How many other palindromes can you find?

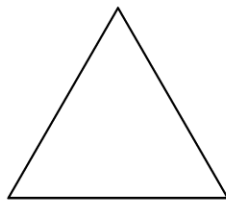

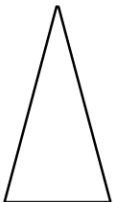
Draw the lines of symmetry for each shape.



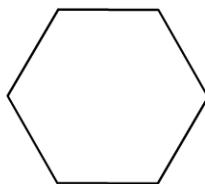
Square



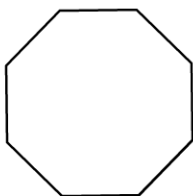
Equilateral Triangle



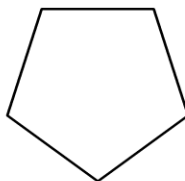
Isosceles Triangle



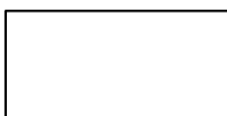
Hexagon
