Writing Structure:

Orientation:

Opening paragraph to introduce the setting and characters.

Body:

Series of paragraphs telling the story, the conflicts that arise and the way the characters resolve the problems.

Conclusion:

A paragraph that concludes the story and may comment on any moral lessons in the story.

Where will your story take place?

Choose some characters. Describe them.

Work out a plot. What will happen to the characters?

What will happen in the end. Will the characters learn from their experience?
