Most adverbs of manner end in *-ly*.  
Exceptions include *well*, *hard*, *late* and *fast*.

Maria waited calmly.

I think you will pass the test easily.

It's raining outside so walk carefully.

She dances well.

He studied hard.

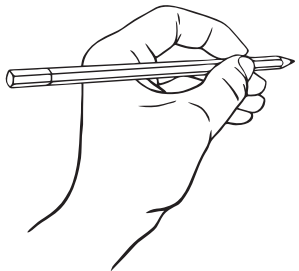
