1) The length of a piece of string is shown.



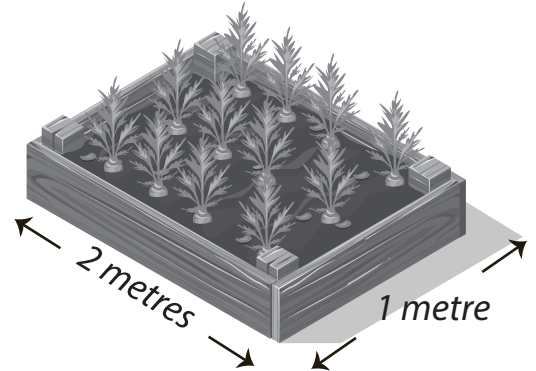
What is the length of each piece if the string is halved? \_\_\_\_\_
