The suffix “er” can be added to a word to create an adjective that describes a person according to their activity or employment.

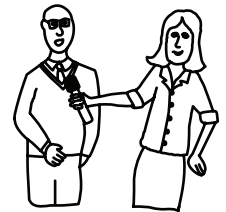
