Moths and butterflies

Butterflies and moths are insects and have a head, thorax, abdomen, two antennae, and six legs. Moths and butterflies also have four wings.

Interesting butterfly facts

Butterflies range in size from a few millimeters to almost 30 centimeters! Butterflies have their skeleton on the outside of their body. It is called an exoskeleton. No adult butterfly can live more than a year. Butterflies taste with their feet.

Butterflies do not have mouths. They have a long straw like structure called a proboscis which they use to drink nectar and juices. Can you find any more interesting butterfly facts?

Colours and patterns

There are three reasons for the colours and patterns on a butterfly.

- 1. It is brightly coloured because it is poisonous. This warns other animals not to eat them.
- 2. The butterfly uses the colours and patterns to attract mates to breed with.
- 3. Some butterflies have dull colours for camouflage. This makes it hard for predators to find them.

- 4. adult butterfly




