

Majungasaurus

Means "meaning here" Scientific name: Majungasaurus crenatissimus (previously Megalosaurus crenatissimus)

Period:

Late Cretaceous (~ 70 – 66 Ma -{Mega annum, or million years ago}) **Diet:** Carnivore (meat eater) **Current day location found:** Madagascar

More information:

- Named after the Mahajanga region of Madagascar
- Like all abelisaurids it was a bipedal predator with a short snout
- Had more teeth than most abelisaurids
- Had a rounded horn on top of its skull
- It was the top predator in its area

- Preyed on sauropods and sometimes even other Majungasaurus
- Was only medium sized for a theropod
- Estimated length 7 to 8 m (23 to 26 ft)
- Estimated weight about 1 tonne (about the same as 1 ¹/₂ dairy cows)
